POSITION OBJECTIVE:

Provide individual, complimentary Reiki sessions to patients while they are receiving care at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS:

- Level I Reiki Practitioner or higher, in practice for a minimum of 6 months, *with training program completed in-person with accredited Reiki Master Teacher (must provide copy of Reiki certificates)*
- Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to maintain a professional, friendly, compassionate environment
- Familiarity with healthcare environments is preferred
- Ability to take direction from medical staff
- Good command of the English language (*bi-lingual abilities a plus*) and good listening skills
- Must be able to stand or sit for 25 - 40 minutes (*average 2 mini-sessions per hour*)
- Commitment of 4 hours per month, for a minimum of 1 year
- **Written recommendation by Reiki Master/Reiki Master Teacher, and one additional written, professional letter of reference**
- Completion of Volunteer Services Application
- Clearance through BIDMC Occupational Health Services, providing updated immunizations
- Agreement to follow all protocols and requirements related to the BIDMC Reiki Volunteer Program and BIDMC, including Confidentiality Agreement and Reiki Volunteer Agreement

TRAINING:

- Volunteer Services General Orientation
- BIDMC Information, Security & Privacy Training
- BIDMC Integrity at Work Training
- BIDMC Reiki Specific Training/Orientation
- Shadowing sessions with experienced Reiki practitioner at the hospital, at the discretion of the Reiki Program Coordinator
